- Cuddle up and watch a movie at the popular 'Sussex Drive-In' - No speakers hanging on windows anymore, no mosquitoes getting in!
- Take a drive on the fabulous, scenic Fundy Trail Parkway; take a picnic or stop for a lunch! You can start at either Sussex Corner or at St Martin’s. The paved road is beautiful and the views at the lookouts are awesome! (A few small rest stops are along the way.) 😊
