1. Resurgo Place and The Free Meeting House



Join us for a complimentary tour of the Free Meeting House and Resurgo Place. One of Moncton's oldest public buildings, the **Free Meeting House** was built in 1821 with the purpose of serving all denominations which did not have a church. After years of neglect, a complete restoration was completed in 1990 and the Free Meeting House was designated a National Historic Site.



Resurgo Place is the new home of the Moncton Museum and the Transportation Discovery Centre. The name "Resurgo" means "I rise again" which was the first motto (1890) of the city of Moncton. The current facility opened in 2014 and includes an information centre, galleries, an interactive exhibition focussing on transportation, an education centre, a research centre and a public area which includes the façade of the former Moncton City Hall.

2. Petitcodiac Riverfront Walk



A facilitated walk along the Petitcodiac River, various monuments and sites along the path will be pointed out to those taking part in this wellness event. The experience will give participants an opportunity to learn about the numerous people and cultures that helped to build Moncton's history. Comfortable footwear is suggested.

3. Crow and Vine Winery Bus Tour



Located in Memramcook, the Crow and Vine Winery opened its doors in July 2024. The 6-acre vineyard offers 11 French cold-climate varietals and yields 4,000 to 5,000 litres of wine each year. Participants will be offered bus transportation and a wine tasting along with a tour of the vineyard and winery. This interesting tour costs \$25 per person (please include with registration).
